What we've found particularly powerful about LSP is how it fosters inclusivity and boosts participation. In our diverse classrooms, where students may struggle to express themselves in traditional ways, LSP offers an alternative form of communication through the physical act of building. It allows all students—regardless of background or learning ability—to contribute and collaborate in a meaningful way. By creating a space where creativity and teamwork are prioritized, LSP helps our students develop stronger connections with the material and with each other, making learning both fun and deeply impactful.
