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## **Hospitality Escape Room Challenge**

#### **Objective**

Engage students in experiential learning through a hospitality-themed escape room challenge that integrates real-world problem-solving, critical thinking, and teamwork.

# How It Works

#### 1. Scenario Creation

Design an escape room scenario set in a hospitality environment, such as a hotel experiencing a crisis (e.g., a celebrity check-in gone wrong, a kitchen disaster, or a technology failure in the front office).

#### 2. Challenges & Puzzles

- Role-Specific Tasks: Assign students different hospitality roles like front desk manager, event planner, or chef.
- Themed Puzzles: Create tasks that require industry-specific knowledge, such as solving menu pricing errors, deciphering a guest's complex room service request, or managing a double-booking issue.

#### 3. Escape Room Setup

Use a physical classroom, virtual platform (if online), or even Augmented Reality (AR) apps. Decorate the space with hospitality-related props like room keys, reservation lists, and menus.

#### 4. Assessment & Debrief

After the challenge, debrief by discussing the decision-making process, customer service techniques used, and team collaboration outcomes. Link each puzzle to hospitality



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competencies like operations management, customer service excellence, and conflict resolution.
