## **Faculty Position in Hospitality and Tourism Management (Assistant Professor) School of Hotel and Tourism Management, CUHK Business School**

The School of Hotel and Tourism Management at the Business School of the Chinese University of Hong Kong is inviting applications for a tenure-track faculty position in hospitality and tourism, starting in August 2026.

Applicants should be promising scholars with a PhD (by the time of reporting for duty) in hospitality and tourism or a related field. The appointees will conduct high quality research which results in publications in top-tier hospitality and tourism journals. In addition, they are expected to undertake duties to teach basic and advanced-level hospitality and tourism courses at both undergraduate and/or postgraduate levels, and to render services to the School of Hotel and Tourism Management. We welcome applications from scholars specializing in AI and technology, human resources, supply chain management, healthcare and aging, and related areas. Industry experience in related fields and/or grant experience is preferred.

Appointment will normally be made on contract basis for up to three years initially commencing August 2026, which, subject to demonstration of the requisite level of performance and mutual agreement, may lead to a longer-term appointment or substantiation later.
